

GENUINE STORIES OF THE OLD TOWN

Old Town of Raahe is one of the best-preserved **19th-century wooden towns** in Finland. Not a museum area but a living town district, Old Town tells the tale of the construction of a town and life in it from centuries ago to the modern day. The best way to experience it is by taking an unhurried walk along the narrow streets. Stop for a moment and **enjoy coffee** and pastries. Here you can also find **unique and unusual accommodation**. Come on board the Raahe Guides Association **guided walking tours** through the town and its stories.

MULTITUDE OF MUSEUMS

Raahe's seven museums offer something for everyone. The Crown Granary is home to the Old Gentleman, **the oldest diving suit in the world**. The Packhouse Museum in the former Customs House and Packhouse has an exhibition where you can find **something new on every visit**. The **home museum** in the Sovelius House gives visitors a glimpse of the life of a wealthy 19th-century shipowner. **The Old Pharmacy's collection** sheds light on the history of illness and healing. **The three local history museums** tell you the stories about life and sources of livelihood in the old days. raahenmuseo.fi/en

AN ARCHIPELAGO FULL OF HISTORY

Recreation in marine nature and spending summer days in the archipelago have been part of the life of people in Raahe for centuries. The Raahe archipelago, Finnish Outdoor Destination of the Year 2016, welcomes you to visit, either independently by boat or canoe or on an archipelago cruise. Hop on board and spend a lovely **summer day on the beach on Tasku Island**, learn about the unique nature shaped by post-glacial rebound on the **nature trail on Iso-Kraaseli Island** or enjoy the peace and quiet on the **rocky shores of Kalla Island**. The trip to these islands takes about 20 minutes. If you want to see the archipelago without disembarking, the cruise takes about two hours. The cruise season usually starts in May and continues long into the autumn, weather permitting. **Daily boat rides** begin around Midsummer, and the cruises start from the pier of the Packhouse Museum, Rantakatu 33. BECOME ONE WITH THE NATURE

The diverse Raahe archipelago offers wonderful destinations for outdoor activities. Go **canoeing or stand-up paddleboarding**, either on a guided trip or independently. A local fisherman will help you find the best spots on **fishing trips** in the summer and winter. Go **hiking or cycling** on the beautiful forest trails of Vihanti or Hummastiinvaara or on the seaside nature trails right next to the town centre. In the winter, you can go out on the frozen sea by **walking, skiing or fatbiking**. The skiing trails on the mainland start almost from the hotel door.

SAIL RIGHT IN

The piers in front of the Packhouse Museum and Ruiskuhuone Café, near the town centre, offer short-term mooring points for visiting boats free of charge. A full-service marina Terässatama, harbour number 1868, is just a stone's throw away. In the summer season, the marina offers, among other things, 24/7 fuel service with a card payment terminal. The pontoon piers of the islands of Iso-Kraaseli, Tasku, Kalla and Ulkopauha are available to boaters from mid-June to the turn of August/September.

WELCOME TO IDYLLIC RAAHE

The sea and the rivers, the waters and the winds, life in its many forms... All these have made us what we are: some might call us stubborn and sulky, while others think that we are full of joy and excitement for life. We have lived by the waters, made our living from them, used them for travelling. RAAHEN RANTAJATSIT - JAZZ ON THE BEACH


an original and intimate music festival on the last weekend of July.
